NOTES / COMMENTS

- a) Each team is given round robin points - 3 for win, 2 for no result, 0 for loss
- b) If pools teams are on same points after round robin then NRR will determine pool rankings.
(runs per over scored "minus" runs per over conceded)

c) After pool play teams are re-ranked, and play off matches are played for placings ie Pool A 1st vs Pool B 1st (1st/2nd), Pool A 2nd vs Pool B 2nd (3rd/4th), etc

- d) All games, ceremonies and meetings will take place at venue
- e) there will be a Tournament Controllers tent at the grounds where all meetings and queries are to take place
- f) Tournament Team - independent selectors will watch the games and use batting/bowling statistics to assist them to select a 13-person tournament team
- g) all games are 20-over innings, unless there is a late start or weather affected game in which case the umpires and/or Tournament Controller can decide on a reduced over game
